The matter relates to selection process of the Bihar Public Service Commission regarding 42nd Combined Competitive Examination. The learned counsel for the appellant submitted that the persons ^{Lal} have secured lessor marks than the appellant have been selected whereas the rightful claim of the appellant has been negatived. The candidates who have been selected belong to reserved category for which qualifying marks is lessor than the general category to which the appellant belongs. In that view of the matter, the point urged on behalf of the appellant cannot be accepted. We fully agree with the view taken by the learned Single Judge that on the basis of vague allegation of illegalities, the examination held by the constitutional authority cannot be interfered with.

In the result, the appeal is dismissed.
