The appeal suffers from delay of 93 days and for that an application (IA. No.3890 of 2008) has been made. Even if we condone the delay in filing the appeal, we find that the appeal has no merit.

2. The counsel for the appellants submits that even if there is no provision for re-evaluation, when there is gross error in assessment of the answer book, re-evaluation can be ordered.

3. We are afraid, there is no such proposition as is sought to be canvassed.

4. The appeal has no merit. It is dismissed in limine.

5. This disposes of IA No.3890 of 2008 as well.
